

PERFORMING ARTS (Drama, Dance, Musical or Theatrical Theatre) BTEC Technical Award in Performing Arts

If you enjoy Drama, Dance, Musical or Theatrical Theatre, this could be the course for you.



The BTEC Technical Award is the equivalent of one GCSE.

This course is focused on 'Performance' and offers a wide range of options in the three disciplines of Drama, Dance and Musical Theatre. You will gain experience of the understanding, knowledge and skills associated with practices and processes of the performing arts industry and acquire a general view of the variety of skills required for stage performance.

There are 3 components to complete during the course:

Component 1: Exploring the Performing Arts

This is internally assessed. Learners will develop their understanding of the performing arts by examining practitioners' work and the processes used to create performance.

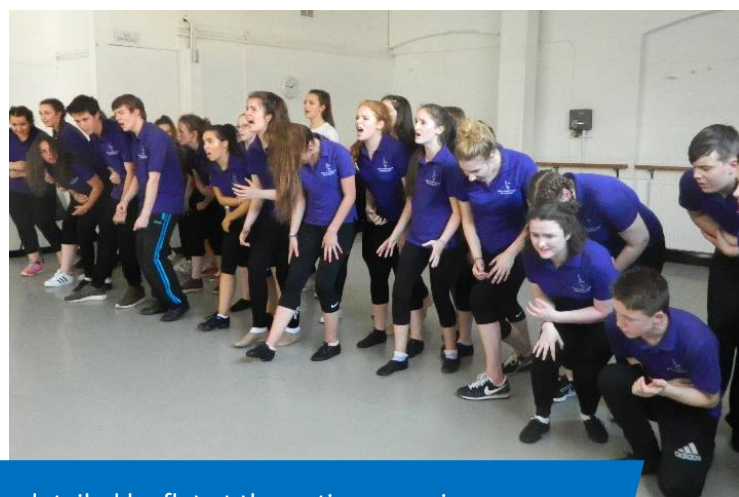
Component 2: Developing skills and technique in Performing Arts

This is internally assessed. Learners will develop their performing arts skills and techniques through the reproduction of musical theatre repertoire.

Component 3: Performing to a brief

This is externally set and assessed by the examining body. Learners will be given the opportunity to work as part of a group to create a workshop performance in response to a given brief and stimulus.

Students who take either GCSE Drama or the BTEC Technical Award in Performing Arts will be able to progress to A Level Drama and Theatre Studies or BTEC Nationals Level 3 Performing Arts courses that we offer in the Sixth Form.
